Please include footnotes instead of endnotes, and refrain from using headers. Article submissions must include an abstract of no more than 200 words. Abstracts are not necessary for book reviews or essays.

Authors of submissions accepted for publication will be asked to provide a short biography including your major and class designation, graduation date, research interests, plans after graduation, hometown, and any academic honors or affiliations for the contributors' page.
