Submission Guidelines

The Alexandrian accepts submissions of book reviews, articles, and essays on history, philosophy, and religion. All submissions must be in Microsoft Word and adhere to the *Chicago Manual of Style*. Please include footnotes instead of endnotes, and refrain from using headers. Article submissions must include an abstract of no more than 200 words. Abstracts are not necessary for book reviews or essays.

Authors of submissions accepted for publication will be asked to provide a short biography including your major and class designation, graduation date, research interests, plans after graduation, hometown, and any academic honors or affiliations for the contributors' page. Biographies should be no more than 100 words. Please be sure your name is written as you would like it to appear in the journal. Send all submissions to alexandrian@troy.edu.
